Candid

Over the last few months, many members of our church have been in forthright discussion about the current status and the future of First Pres Waukesha. There is solace in the sense of so many people feeling genuine love for this church family. It continues to be challenging to find a new Pastor, but being candid with each other helps us to be supportive and encouraging.

Jesus was quite honest with his Apostles; in fact, sometimes he spoke so freely they didn't understand his words, because God's ways were unfamiliar and unexpected. Even though Jesus had told them in advance how he would be taken, crucified, and then rise again, they were astonished when it played out. We would probably have been the same. Today, we sometimes fall into similar contradictions: we recognize that congregations change over time, but we want it to be different for us. We remember the advice from Ecclesiastes "For everything there is a season, a time for every activity under heaven. ... God has made everything beautiful for its own time. He has planted eternity in the human heart, but even so, people cannot see the whole scope of God's work from beginning to end."

During the summer, we will continue our work to find a new Pastor, we will continue to be Christ's people in our community, and we will work with each other, side by side, and share each others joys and burdens through any change. Let's remain hopeful that in God's providence, a truly special person is being prepared to lead our worship, care for our fold, and help us discern the future together.


